FOI REQUEST: DERBY STATION FOOTBRIDGE - RIGHT OF WAY

1. Please could you confirm whether the Derby railway station footbridge is designated as a Public Right of Way (PRoW)?	<p>Derby Railway Station footbridge is not recorded as a public right of way.</p> <p>A through route from the station's Railway Terrace entrance to Pride Park did not exist until the Pride Park entrance was constructed in the early 2000s.</p> <p>The Council entered into an agreement with Midland Main Line Limited, the railway station operator of the time, to provide free pedestrian access across the footbridge for those not using the station for rail travel, in 2001.</p> <p>A later agreement was made with the station operator, East Midlands Trains Limited in 2009, to allow the installation of a gate and pass system.</p> <p>Station customers should check with the current station operator, East Midlands Railway, for details.</p>
