1. Total number of people living at risk of flooding (any level of risk)	<p>For each of the three questions, we do not hold the specific data requested. However, the data applicant might be interested to read the Council's 2011 Preliminary Flood Risk Assessment (PFRA) which contains some information that might be useful and relevant. The PFRA is available to view and download on the Council's website here:</p> <p>https://www.derby.gov.uk/media/derbycitycouncil/contentassets/documents/environmentandplanning/floodinganddrainage/derby-city-pfra-2011-report.pdf.</p> <p>For example, Section 7 of the report states that "the total estimated number of people at risk of flooding for a 0.5% (1 in 200 probability) event in Derby is (approximately) 13,600 for the >0.3m depth range". The value of 13,600 people also appears again in Table 5.1 in the PFRA report.</p>
2. Total number of people exposed to frequent flooding (1:75 years or above)	<p>The data request is for the numbers of people at risk from flooding from all and various flood frequency events and also broken down by EA flood zone.</p> <p>This Council has not broken down the available data (flood zones, property addresses and other data such as census data) to derive the values the data applicant is requesting. However, this data will be available freely on the internet through open Government data sources, for example on https://www.data.gov.uk/, should they wish to calculate this themselves.</p>
